Itinerary



This suggested itinerary is to help both of us manage our time.

The demonstrations are run by volunteers so they are timetabled.

The following itinerary is highly recommended:

- Arrive (usual estimated time of arrival is 9:30am). Have a 10 − 15 minute food and toilet break.
- On the day of your visit your group will be split into small groups of no more than 28 students and five adults. The train has only 30 seats (room for 28 students and two adults).

Note: At times this may need to be reduced to smaller groups due to maintenance work

- You will be given a timetable for the demonstrations. These will be from 10:00am to 12.30pm in 20 minute blocks (including moving time).
- The number of activities will be dependant on how many groups your school will be divided into and what is available on the day. (Due to volunteer numbers not every demonstration is available on all days).
- Around 12:30pm have lunch.
- After lunch you have free time until you depart. (There is an activity booklet available to download from our website for the students to complete if required.)

Your Day at the Village

Bus Arrives

Our volunteer village demonstrators and wranglers meet with your group at which time they will request the following information.

- Who is in charge of your group?
- Are there any special needs?
- What is your departure time?
- Will the bus driver be staying?

The number of students, teachers and parents attending on the day are confirmed to calculate the correct entry fee charge to be invoiced.

Entry to the Village

Your group will then be taken into the village and down to the hotel verandah where they will have the morning tea they have brought with them, prior to commencing the activities. They will also be split into groups for the demonstrations and train ride. Bags may be left on the verandah while you are attending demonstrations.

A short talk on general housekeeping in the village will include:

- Toilet locations.
- Vehicle awareness around the village.
- Reminder about hats.
- No running
- Lunch Teachers and parents who wish to order lunch at the village café should do so while the students are having morning tea.

Teachers will be given a schedule for the day with a village map on the back. The map includes the location of toilets and water bubblers.

Activities Commence

The school group is guided to the schoolhouse for parade with a stop at the toilets on the way. The ringing of the school bell signifies the start of the demonstrations. Groups are lined up in front of an animal totem which will signify which group they belong to when moving around the village.

Once parade is completed each group will go to their first scheduled demonstration. Groups will rotate through all demonstrations allocated on the day.

Lunch

At approximately 12:30 you will return to the hotel verandah to have lunch. Parents who have ordered lunch from the café can collect it at this time.

After lunch, time is allocated for you to explore the rest of the village. Prior to departure it is recommended the students have the opportunity to visit the toilets.

Departure

Our wranglers will guide your group safely back to the bus. Be sure to check for items left behind on the hotel verandah before departure.
